I have 2 projects: MainProject and another one, Project1. If I want to build an application that is deployed as a standalone exe, then I need to add a reference from MainProject to Project1. If that is the case, then I need to build MainProject and make the executable (it is supposed to be a standalone application), then copy the executable to the directory where I have put Project1 and then run it. This is a single solution project so it has all the files in a single directory. Is that correct? Or am I missing something? A: The only thing I see is a Main Project with a reference to a "Support" project. I would also include a "Support" project (if you want to call it that) and simply reference the one project from the Main Project and you can build and debug that project and then build the "Support" project and then copy the executable over to the main directory and run it from there. If you want to make the whole thing a single project then you
